Diego initially studied the classical guitar in 1988 with Miguel Fréire. In 1992 he started his studies in modern harmony with Rubén Perez, Marcos Fernandez and Mario Grimaldi. In 1994 he enrolled in the Ateneo Jazz Academy in Madrid, under the instruction of the prestigious professor Felix Santos Guindel (Cum Laude from Berkley School).

In 1998 he began his studies in Flamenco with Ignacio de León and afterwards with the Grand Master Jose Manuel Montoya. A musician who has played sessions with diverse national and international artist(+ 200 bands and 3.000 concerts), working as a studio musician (+60 recordings), arranging and composing music for theatre, tv, advertising etc.

Tonichi commenced his musical journey at 15 in a self-taught manner. At 19 he began his studies in modern harmony under the instruction of Gabriel Celester. At the age of 23 he graduated with a teaching degree in music while continuing his development in harmony and contemporary music and spent a year in the Permanent Jazz Seminary in Pontevedra.

He has belonged to numerous bands, of particular note, the Festicultores Troupe and Miñor Swing, and has travelled around the world and shared stages with artists of notable international recognition. At present, he combines his studies with his professional career and his work as a guitar teacher.
